5. Number of Participants: 50 students and 3 faculty members


6. About overall conduct:



What is **not** Patentable

Sec. 3 and 4 of the Indian Patents Act, 1970 lay down that the following inventions are non-patentable as these cease to be inventions:

- 1. A frivolous invention, which claims anything which is obvious, or contrary to the universal laws of Nature
- 2. Any invention, the use of which would be contrary to the law, or morality, or injurious to public health;
- 3 Any scientific discovery or theory like Copernicus Theory, or, theory of relativity, and/or mathematical method:
