

## What is not Patentable

Sec. 3 and 4 of the Indian Patents Act, 1970 lay down that the following inventions are non-patentable as these cease to be inventions :

1. A frivolous invention, which claims anything which is obvious, or contrary to the universal laws of Nature
2. Any invention, the use of which would be contrary to the law, or morality, or injurious to public health;
- 3 Any scientific discovery or theory like Copernicus Theory, or, theory of relativity, and/or mathematical method;
